ABOUT
IMMIGRATION EASY TO SUPPORT TOURISM
SUSTAINABLE IN THE 2019 *CORONA VIRUS DISEASE* PANDEMIC

1. Background

- a. That to optimize the function of immigration as a development facilitator community welfare and support the government's policy of reopening tourism sector more broadly with the concept of sustainable *tourism tourism*), it is necessary to provide immigration facilities based on the principle of reciprocity and the principle of benefit in the form of granting a visa-free visit and a current visit visa arrivals are limited to certain foreigners;
- b. That based on the results of the evaluation, it is deemed necessary to adjust several provisions in the Circular of the Director General of Immigration Number IMI-0603.GR.01.01 2022 concerning Ease of Immigration to Support Tourism Sustainability during the *Corona Virus Disease 2019* Pandemic by adding Colombia, Maldives and Monaco to the list of countries whose citizens Immigration facilities are given in the form of a special visit visa on arrival tourism and add a Special Visit Visa-Free Immigration Checkpoint Sightseeing and Immigration Checkpoints Visit Visa On Arrival Special Tour;
- c. Whereas based on the considerations as referred to in letters a and b, it is necessary issue a Circular Letter of the Director General of Immigration regarding the Ease of Immigration In Order to Support Sustainable Tourism During the *Corona Virus* Pandemic *Disease 2019*.

2. Purpose and goals

- a. The purpose of the issuance of this circular is to optimize immigration support in the opening of the tourism sector during the 2019 *Corona Virus Disease* pandemic;
- b. The purpose of issuing this circular is to monitor, control, and evaluation of the implementation of the Immigration Facilitation policy in order to support sustainable tourism during the 2019 *Corona Virus Disease* Pandemic.

3. Scope

The scope of this circular is to confirm the immigration function to support the reopening of the tourism sector during the 2019 *Corona Virus Disease* Pandemic.

4. Basic

- a. Law Number 6 of 2011 concerning Immigration;
- b. Law Number 11 of 2020 concerning Job Creation;
- c. Government Regulation Number 31 of 2013 concerning Regulations Implementing Laws Law Number 6 of 2011 concerning Immigration as has been several times last amended by Government Regulation Number 48 of 2021 concerning Amendments Third, on Government Regulation Number 31 of 2013 concerning Regulations Implementation of Law Number 6 of 2011 concerning Immigration;
- d. Presidential Decree Number 24 of 2021 concerning Determination of the Factual Status of the Pandemic *Corona Virus Disease* 2019 (Covid-19) in Indonesia;
- e. Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 44 of 2015 concerning Governance How to Check In and Out of Indonesian Territory at the Checkpoint Immigration;
- f. Minister of Law and Human Rights Regulation Number 28 of 2018 concerning Immigration Stamp;
- g. Minister of Law and Human Rights Regulation Number 29 of 2021 concerning Visas and Residence Permit;
- h. Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 34 of 2021 concerning Granting Immigration Visas and Residence Permits During the Handling Period *Corona Virus Disease* 2019 and National Economic Recovery;
- i. Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 41 of 2021 concerning Organization and Work Procedure of the Ministry of Law and Human Rights;
- j. *Addendum* to Circular Letter of the Chairperson of the Covid-19 Handling Task Force Number 22 of 2022 concerning Health Protocols for Overseas Travel During the *Corona* Pandemic *Virus Disease* 2019 (COVID-19).

5. Contents of the Circular

a. General:

So that all officers and service implementers:

- 1) Performing excellent service to the community;
- 2) Do not commit Corruption, Collusion and Nepotism;
- 3) Carry out supervision in stages;
- 4) Coordinate and socialize with *stakeholders* and immigration guarantor regarding this circular.

b. Head of the Immigration Division of the Regional Office of the Ministry of Law and Human Rights:

- 1) Conducting guidance, control, supervision, and evaluation of the implementation of the Immigration Ease of Policy in the Context of Supporting Tourism Sustainability during the 2019 *Corona Virus Disease* Pandemic ;

- 2) Report the results of the evaluation of the implementation of the policy periodically every 7 (seven) days to the Director General of Immigration.

c. Head of Immigration Office:

- 1) Disseminate information to *stakeholders* and the wider community and carry out the necessary coordination in the context of the Ease of Immigration Policy in Indonesia To Support Sustainable Tourism During the *Corona Virus* Pandemic Disease 2019;
- 2) Carry out immigration surveillance and immigration intelligence activities in the region work;
- 3) Ensure the owner or manager of the inn in his work area provide information or data about foreigners staying at home or at the place of lodging;
- 4) Imposing sanctions on owners or administrators of lodging places who do not provide information or not provide data on foreigners staying at the the house / place of lodging in accordance with the provisions of the legislation invitation;
- 5) Imposing sanctions on foreigners holding Special Visit Visa Free Tourists or holders of a Visit Visa on Special Arrival who are carry out activities that are not in accordance with the intent and purpose of granting a Stay Permit which are given;
- 6) Imposing sanctions on foreigners who are proven to have committed violations in accordance with the provisions of the legislation in the field of immigration and/or violates public order in the implementation of health protocols;
- 7) The imposition of sanctions on foreigners who violate public order implementation of the health protocol as referred to in number 6) is carried out after receiving a recommendation from the agency carrying out the task handling/controlling Covid-19;
- 8) Doing an extension of Immigration Stay Permit originating from a Visit Visa On Arrival Special Tours;
- 9) Controlling the implementation of immigration inspection activities in Immigration Checkpoints and/or immigration control;
- 10) Report the implementation of activities periodically to the Head of the Immigration Division.

d. Head of the Immigration Office in charge of the designated Immigration Checkpoint by the Head of the Covid-19 Task Force as the entry point for the arrival of citizens Indonesians and foreigners:

- 1) Ensuring the implementation of immigration checks in the Immigration Area which includes bank counter, arrival area immigration counter, and departure area immigration counter can meet the provisions of the health protocol in accordance with the provisions of the regulations legislation;
- 2) Ensuring the Person in Charge of the Transport Equipment carries out obligations in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations in the field of immigration;

- 3) Conduct immigration checks on Indonesian citizens, equipment crew transportation, foreigners holding Diplomatic Passports or Service Passports provided with Diplomatic Visa Free or Service Visa Free facilities, foreigners holding Visa or Stay Permit, and foreigners holding APEC KPP in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations;
- 4) Visa or Stay Permit as referred to in number 3) consists of:
 - a) Diplomatic Visa,
 - b) Service Visa,
 - c) Visit Visa,
 - d) Limited Stay Visa,
 - e) Diplomatic Residence Permit,
 - f) Official Residence Permit,
 - g) Permanent Stay Permit, or
 - h) Limited Stay Permit;
- 5) Rejecting entry to foreigners and giving Marks
Exit in accordance with statutory provisions.

e. Head of the Immigration Office as listed in Attachment I and Attachment II of the letter this circular:

- 1) Instruct the Administrative Officer in charge of inspection
immigration at Immigration Checkpoints:
 - a) Granting Visa Free Special Visits for Tourists in Places
Immigration Check as contained in Attachment I to this circular letter,
 - b) Granting a Visit Visa on Arrival Special for Tourism in Places
Immigration Check as contained in Attachment II of this circular letter,
 - c) The granting of a Special Tourist Visit Visa as referred to in letter a) is carried out through an immigration check in accordance with Article 23 paragraph (1) and paragraph (2) of the Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 44 of 2015 concerning Governance How to Check In and Out of Indonesian Territory at the Checkpoint Immigration of foreign nationals of the State, Regional Government Special Administrative of a Country, and Certain Entities Subject to Visa Free Special Tour Visits;
 - d) Entry Signs in granting Special Tourist Visit Visa Free refer to Entry Signs and Stay Permits subject to visa-free visits in the Regulations Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 28 of 2018 concerning Immigration Stamp which is valid as a Visit Stay Permit with a maximum period of 30 (thirty) days and cannot be extended;
 - e) State, Government of a Special Administrative Region of a State, and Entities
Certain Subjects of Free Visa for Special Visits for Tourism, namely:
 - (1) Brunei Darussalam,
 - (2) Philippines,
 - (3) Cambodia,
 - (4) Laos,
 - (5) Malaysia,
 - (6) Myanmar,
 - (7) Singapore,
 - (8) Thailand, and
 - (9) Vietnamese;

- f) The granting of a Visit Visa on Special Arrival for Tourism as referred to in letter b) is carried out through an immigration check in accordance with Article 23 and Article 26 letter b of the Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 44 of 2015 against foreigners who are nationals of the State, Administrative Region Government Specific to a Country, and Certain Entities Subject to a Current Visit Visa Special Arrival Tours;
- g) Entry Signs in granting a Visit Visa on Special Arrival Tourism refer to the Entry Sign and Stay Permit of the current visit visa holder arrival in the Regulation of the Minister of Law and Human Rights Number 28 of 2018 which is valid as a Visit Stay Permit with a maximum period of 30 (thirty) days which can be extended for a maximum of 1 (one) extension for a period of 30 (thirty) days at the Immigration Office whose working area covers the residence of foreigners and cannot be transferred;
- h) State, Government of a Special Administrative Region of a State, and Entities Certain Subjects of Visit Visa on Special Arrival for Tourism, namely:

i) Granting of Free Tourist Visit Visa and Current Visit Visa

Tour Special Arrival is done by checking the requirements as following:

(1) Nationality Passport includes:

- (a) Diplomatic Passport,
- (b) Service Passport, or
- (c) Ordinary Passport/General Passport,

valid and still valid for at least 6 (six) months,

(2) A return ticket or a one-way ticket to continue the journey to another country, and

(3) Proof of payment of PNPB for a visit visa upon arrival, in the case of a person

Foreigners apply for a Visit Visa on Special Arrival for Tourism,

j) Free Tourist Visit Visa and Visit Visa on Arrival

Special Tours can be used by foreigners to carry out tourism activities or government duties in international activities of a state nature or government;

k) In the event that the foreigner as referred to in letter j) will perform

activities of government duties in international activities that are state or government, in addition to meeting the requirements as referred to in letter i) must also attach a letter of invitation to attend conferences/sessions/meetings published by the Ministry/Agency/Agencies of the Republic of Indonesia;

l) A Special Tourist On-Arrival Visit Visa can also be issued to

foreigners holding Diplomatic Passports or Service Passports who are not citizens of the State, Government of a Special Administrative Region of a State, and Certain Entities Subject to Visit Visa on Arrival Special Tours in the event that there is no Representative of the Republic of Indonesia in the country/residence or activities that are sudden/urgent, by checking the requirements as follows:

(1) A valid and valid Diplomatic Passport or Service Passport

short 6 (six) months,

- (2) A return ticket or a one-way ticket to continue the journey to another country,
 - (3) Request letter from the Ministry/Agency/Agency of the Republic of Indonesia,
 - (4) Letter of approval from the Director General of Immigration,
 - (5) Proof of PNPB payment for visit visa upon arrival, and
 - (6) Invitation letter to attend conferences/trials/meetings issued by Ministries/
Institutions/Agencies of the Republic of Indonesia, in terms of the intention of
the arrival of foreigners for government duties in international activities of a state
or government nature;
- m) Application for approval letter from the Director General of Immigration as referred to
in letter l) number (4) is submitted by the leadership of the Ministry/Institution/Agency
of the Republic of Indonesia to the Director General of Immigration up to the Director
of Immigration Traffic by attaching:
- (1) Letter of request from the Ministry/Institution/Agency of the Republic of Indonesia which
contain the data of foreigners and the reasons for the submission,
 - (2) A valid and valid Diplomatic Passport or Service Passport
short 6 (six) months, and
 - (3) A return ticket or a one-way ticket to continue the journey to another country;
- n) Foreigner holders of Free Visit Visa and Special Tourist Visa
Visits on Arrival Special Tours cannot apply for a Stay Permit
New through Visa application;
- o) Foreigner holders of Free Visit Visa and Special Tourist Visa
Visits on Arrival Special Tours can leave the territory of Indonesia
through all Immigration Checkpoints;
- p) The applicable rates for a Special Tourist Arrival Visit Visa are
Visit Visa rates on Arrival as referred to in the Appendix
Government Regulation Number 28 of 2019 which is Rp. 500,000,;
- q) Reconcile data between PNPB payments, use of Visa stickers
Special Arrival Visits, with immigration crossing
on a daily, weekly and monthly basis;
- 2) Reporting periodically the granting of Visa-Free Special Tourist Visits and
Visit Visa on Arrival Special for Tourism to the Head of the Immigration Division.

6. Cover

- a. With the stipulation of this circular, the Director General of Immigration Circular Letter
Number IMI-0603.GR.01.01 of 2022 concerning Ease of Immigration in
To Support Sustainable Tourism During the *Corona Virus* Pandemic
Disease 2019 is revoked and declared invalid;
- b. This circular letter is effective on July 27, 2022 at 00.00 WIB and will be
further evaluated.
